CITY COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of December 1, 2009. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes are the official record of the meeting once they are approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of December 1, 2009, the City Council:

- Awarded a contract for the Freer Street Asphalt Overlay Project;
- Directed staff to collect the necessary data to undertake a Citywide Traffic Calming Study and Master Plan through a Request For Proposal (RFP) process;
- Directed staff to return at the January 5th meeting with recommendations to alleviate parking using the results of a Downtown Parking Survey conducted by Avant Garde;
- Directed staff to work with Avant Garde and the Chamber to bring back a proposal for a Farmer's Market with costs for Council's consideration at the January 5th meeting;
- Appointed Mayor Vizcarra and Mayor Pro Tem Yu as a Council Ad Hoc Committee to assist staff in a needs assessment regarding items to be replaced or refurbished in the Council Chambers, and obtain costs for recommendation back to Council;
- Approved Recommendations from Parks & Recreation Commission regarding the City's 50th Anniversary events, slogan, and commemorative anniversary seal and related items;
- Agreed to serve as liaison to the newly formed Youth Committee on a rotating basis with Councilmember Chavez appointed to attend the first meeting; and
- Announced the selection of Burke, Williams & Sorensen to serve as the new City Attorney.
