- Community Redevelopment Agency Public Hearing: Adoption of a Revised 5-Year Implementation Plan for the Rosemead Blvd. Redevelopment Project for the Period of January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2015, Illustrating the Agency's Programs and Efforts in Utilizing Available Housing Funds
