CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of March 2, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The official record of the Meeting is the Minutes once approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of March 2, 2010, the City Council:

- Presented a Proclamation to a representative of Temple Station Proclaiming March 2010 as “Safe Communities Month”
- Proclaimed March 15, 2010 as Arbor Day in the City of Temple City and Recognized the Student Arbor Day Poster Contest Winners
- Appointed the first Ten Members to the City’s Youth Committee
- Conducted a Reorganization of the City Council by Re-Appointing Fernando Vizcarra as the Mayor and Appointing Tom Chavez as Mayor Pro Tem for a one-year term
- Adopted a Resolution Ordering the Engineer’s Report to Establish Lighting and Maintenance District Assessment Rates for Fiscal Year 2010-2011
- Awarded a Contract for the Traffic Signals Modification Project on Longden at Rosemead Boulevard and Broadway at Rosemead Boulevard
- Introduced an Ordinance for First Reading Amending the Zoning Code to Allow Commercial Storage of Recreational Vehicles and Boats in the Heavy Commercial (C-3) Zone with Approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP)
- Approved Placement of a Bronze Bust of Walter P. Temple in the Civic Center Complex and requested the City Manager carefully review the City’s Fiscal Year (FY) 2009-2010 Budget to find the necessary funding for the bust
- Received a Closed Session Report from Legal Counsel that the Case of *City of Temple City et al. v. TCD Enterprise, LLC et al.* has been resolved
