At the meeting of April 20, 2010, the City Council:

- Welcomed the Sister City Exchange students from Hawkesbury, Australia
- Heard a presentation from the American Cancer Society regarding their “Relay for Life” event scheduled for June 26 – 27 at Temple City High School
- Received information and a presentation on an emergency operations plan from the Los Angeles County Area “D” Disaster Management Area Coordinator
- Received an overview of the state of Southern California Edison utility and latest upgrades and projects from their Region Manager
- Approved permits for twelve non-profit Temple City organizations to sell “safe and sane” fireworks for the 2010 Season
- Approved a request from the Kmart store to hold a temporary event to promote good oral health on June 12 in their parking lot from 3:30 to 6:30 p.m.
- Approved a Fourth Amendment to the contract with Mayer Hoffman McCann P.C. for professional auditing services
- Received an update from staff regarding the City’s 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary planned events and activities
