**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of August 3, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of August 3, 2010, the City Council:

- Received commendations for the City's energy efficiency practices from the offices of Senator Carol Liu, Assemblyman Anthony Portantino, and Congressman Adam Schiff.
- Received a plaque from the National Committee of the Sister City Organization commemorating the City's 25 Years of partnership with Hawkesbury, Australia.
- Presented another donation of 50 books to the Temple City Library as part of the City's "50 Books for 50 Years" Program.
- Approved the Engineering and Traffic Survey and recommended speed limits by adoption of a Resolution.
- Approved a \$24,000 Consultant Services Agreement with LEDMgt to develop an emergency preparedness program and training for City Council and staff.
- Adopted an Ordinance amending the Zoning Code to allow hedge heights over six feet tall outside of the front yard setback area in residential zones, and to specifically define hedges.
- Certified the City's compliance with the Congestion Management Program for fiscal year 2009-2010 by adoption of a Resolution.
- Received an update from the Chamber of Commerce regarding ongoing programs, upcoming events and new memberships.
- As the Community Redevelopment Agency, approved a \$60,000 Consultant Agreement with Seifel Consulting Inc. to prepare a redevelopment strategy and an economic development assessment plan.
- Received Council Reports on attendance at recent meetings of the National Retailer Pursuit Package Ad Hoc Committee, Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project Ad Hoc Committee, Protocol Ad Hoc Committee, Joint Powers Insurance Authority, and Los Angeles County Sanitation District.
