**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of September 20, 2011. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of September 20, 2011, the City Council:

- Welcomed the newly appointed seven-member Youth Committee for school year 2011-2012.
- Was visited by Jacqueline Wu, a new District representative of Senator Carol Liu.
- Received and filed the annual Supplemental Law Enforcement Service Fund (SLESF) Certified Expenditure Report and Oversight Committee Summary for Fiscal Year 2010-2011.
- Adopted a Resolution approving special residential parking restrictions in the 5800 block of Primrose Avenue.
- Released securities in the amount of \$750 upon completion of street tree improvements at 5231 Sereno Drive, Tract No. 54183.
- Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with Willdan Engineering, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000, to provide the City with housing program consultant services for the Home Improvement Programs until June 30, 2012.
- Approved the Third Amendment to the Consultant Services Agreement with Vanir Construction Management Inc. and a \$350,000 funding allocation from the City Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Proposition 1B Budget for Phases 2 & 3 of the Rosemead Boulevard Project.
- Received the Chamber of Commerce monthly report for August.
- Received Council reports on recent meetings of the California Contract Cities Association, Mosquito Abatement District, Foothill Transit Authority, Art Advisory Group, and Council of Governments.
- Considered an item initiated by Councilmember Sternquist of a Joint Use Agreement with the Historical Society for use of their building and formed an Ad Hoc Committee composed of Councilmember Sternquist and Mayor Chavez to further explore options in this regard.
