

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY**  
**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of January 17, 2012. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of January 17, 2012, the City Council:

- Presented a Certificate of Appointment to Matthew Wong, newly appointed Parks and Recreation Commissioner.
- Received a Certificate of Appreciation from Dr. Kenneth Martin for the City's prompt response in assisting residents and businesses during the wind storm recovery process.
- Approved the request from the Temple City Camellia Festival for authorization to use and control certain public rights-of-way and City park facilities in connection with the 2012 Camellia Festival.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding and In-Kind Services Agreement with the YWCA San Gabriel Valley – Intervale Senior Services to allow the senior lunch program and other related services at Live Oak Park to continue through June 30, 2013.
- Approved progress payment No. 3, in the amount of \$127,164.73, to Christopher R. Morales, Inc. for the Traffic Signal Upgrades on Temple City Boulevard at Las Tunas Drive and Baldwin Avenue at Olive Street Capital Improvement Projects.
- Took no action on the request to approve out of state travel for the Mayor (February 10-13, 2012) to visit Shanghai and Nanjing, China to meet with potential capital investors for The Gateway at Temple City Project.
- Adopted a Resolution adding part-time positions and associated salary ranges to the City's employee class and pay range schedule to allow for the timely implementation of two-year work plan items.
- Conducted a Public Hearing and approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs and allocations for Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
- Introduced an Ordinance on first reading repealing Section 5308 from the Temple City Municipal Code relating to the Uniform Local Sales Tax and Use Tax Ordinance to terminate the existing credit for payment of sales and use taxes paid to the Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency.
- Adopted a Resolution designating the Temple City Community Development and Housing Authority as the successor Housing Agency of the Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency.
- Received Council reports on recent meetings of the Chambers Renovation, Public Arts Advisory, and Budget Ad Hoc Committees.
- Received the Mayor's report on recent meetings with residents and business owners at City Hall, and a report on his participation at a Round Table discussion held at the Ninth District Circuit Court with neighboring legislators on the recovery and reimbursement process following the 2011 wind storm damage.
- As the Community Redevelopment Agency, adopted a Resolution adopting the amended Enforceable Obligation Payment Schedule as allowed by Assembly Bill 26 and recommended by the Supreme Court of the State of California and the City Attorney's Office.
