

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of May 15, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of May 15, 2018, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding only one item of Anticipated Litigation and received a briefing from the City attorney. There is no other reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of Conference with Labor Negotiator and gave staff direction. There is no other reportable action.

At the regular meeting of May 15, 2018, the City Council:

- Presented a Certificate of Recognition to the Temple City High School drum line;
- Presented a Certificate of Recognition to the Temple City High School American Red Cross student club;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 1, 2018;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 1, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting on April 24, 2018;
- Approved a Memorandum of Agreement between the County of Los Angeles, cities of Alhambra, Monterey Park, Pasadena, Rosemead, San Gabriel, San Marino, South Pasadena, and Temple City, and the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments regarding the administration and cost sharing for the preparation of design plans for three load reduction strategy projects for the Rio Hondo River and tributaries, and authorized the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of Agreement;
- Approved an agreement with Transtech Engineers, Inc. to provide building and safety services and public works engineering services and authorized the City Manager to execute the Agreement;
- Accepted the Engineer's Report for the Temple City Citywide Lighting and Maintenance District and set a date for public hearing;
- Received the petty cash and visa card report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5329 authorizing the payment of bills;
- Reviewed and deliberated on the City's Strategic Plan mission and vision statement, values and strategic priorities and confirmed the findings for inclusion into the City's 2018-2021 Strategic Plan Update, directed staff to develop a recommended work program for the Strategic Plan Update that reflects Council's confirmed values and statements, and which supports finalized strategic priorities, and directed staff to present recommended work program for Council review and direction at a budget study session scheduled for May 29, 2018;
- Received updates from the City Manager and City Attorney;
- Received Council reports on items separate from the meeting agenda;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular Successor Agency Meeting of April 17, 2018; and
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5330 SA authorizing the payment of Successor Agency bills.
