

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of June 5, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of June 5, 2018, the City Council:

- Received a presentation introducing Pets of the Month. Those interested in adopting the kittens can call the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society at (626) 286-1159;
- Received an introduction of the adult ambassadors from the Temple City Sister City Association;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 15, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 15, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 29, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 30, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting on May 8, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting of May 16, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meeting of May 9, 2018;
- Directed staff to bring back an agreement with Southland Transit with amended term (i.e., 6 months with the option to extend the agreement month to month thereafter for up to a total of one year at the approval of the City Manager) to provide Dial-A-Ride transportation services. Council also directed staff to submit a plan on how a Request for Proposal will be structured integrating Dial-A-Ride and on-demand local public transportation for residents by the December 18, 2018 meeting. Then depending on the discussion on December 18, 2018, City Council will direct staff to develop and issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for DAR and other transportation programs in January 2019;
- Reviewed and approved the First Amendment to the consultant services agreement with Willdan Engineering to provide housing consultant services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19, which shall not exceed 20 percent of the City's home improvement program's expenditures and shall not exceed \$60,000 and authorized the City Manager to execute the First Amendment;
- Accepted project completion for the Temple City Boulevard Highway Safety Improvement Project (HSIPL-5365(010)), Capital Improvement Project (CIP) No. P 15-06, as performed by All American Asphalt, with a final contract amount of \$1,079,332.34, and authorized the City Manager to file a Notice of Completion with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder and release the retention payment 35 days thereafter;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5331 authorizing the payment of bills;
- Received and filed reimbursement of expenses to City officials for conduct of city business; and
- Received updates from City Attorney and City Manager.
