**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 8, 2018**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Man called the City Council Special Meeting to order at 1:35 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 5938 Kauffman Avenue, Temple City.

A. **CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DISCUSSION**

The City has contracted with the Chamber of Commerce to perform services in support of business promotion, business events and business related public information. City Council is requested to hold a discussion regarding the City's agreement with the Chamber.

City Manager Cook gave a brief overview of the staff report and asked if the Mayor would allow Temple City Chamber of Commerce President/CEO Peter Choi to speak before Council held a discussion.

Temple City Chamber of Commerce President/CEO Choi gave a presentation regarding services they provide to the community.

City Council asked questions and made comments regarding the Chamber of Commerce budget, Temple City Life, and services offered.

Councilmember Chavez left the meeting at 2:12 p.m. and returned at 2:13 p.m.

Jerry Jambazian, Temple City resident, expressed concerns he has with services the Chamber of Commerce provides.

Franklin Ruedel, Chamber of Commerce Board member, commented on merging the Chamber of Commerce with City Hall.

City Council directed staff to review the expectations and scope of services of the Chamber of Commerce's current agreement, explore the option of combining Chamber of Commerce with City Hall, and explore other options in terms of future long term use of the Chamber of Commerce property on Las Tunas Drive and Sultana Ave.
