

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of July 3, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of July 3, 2018, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of Anticipated Litigation and received a briefing from the City Attorney and City Manager. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of Conference with Labor Negotiator, received a briefing from the City Manager, and gave staff direction.

At the regular meeting of July 3, 2018, the City Council:

- Adopted resolutions confirming appointments of City Commissioners;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of June 19, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting on May 22, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting on June 12, 2018;
- Reviewed and approved the final subdivision map for Parcel Map No. 74671 and authorized the City Clerk to certify the parcel map;
- Reviewed and approved the final subdivision map for Parcel Map No. 72355 and authorized the City Clerk to certify the parcel map;
- Reviewed and approved the final subdivision map for Parcel Map No. 74485 and authorized the City Clerk to certify the parcel map;
- Approved the Energy Efficient Light Emitting Diode Fixture Replacement Agreement with Southern California Edison, LS-1 Option E to convert existing High Pressure Sodium streetlight fixtures to LED and authorized the City Manager to sign the LS-1 Option E agreement, Color Temperature Specification form and execute the LS-1 Option E Program with SCE;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5345 authorizing the payment of bills for FY 2017-18;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5346 authorizing the payment of bills for FY 2018-19;
- Upheld the Community Development Director's determination and denied a zoning clearance application for a new accessory dwelling unit located at 5813 Myda Avenue;
- Received a presentation on Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Preview Committee Clean Transportation Funding Local Government Partnership Program and adopted Resolution No. 18-5342; and
- Received updates from City Manager.
