

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of June 19, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of June 19, 2018, the City Council:

- Recognized Temple City High School Varsity Baseball Team and Temple City Sister City Program Student Exchange participants going to Australia;
- Received a presentation from Los Angeles County Government liaison on Safe Clean Water;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of June 5, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of June 8, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of June 8, 2018;
- Received and filed legislative update and initiatives that may impact City operations;
- Approved the rate adjustment request for waste services made by Athens Services to become effective July 1, 2018;
- Approved a First Amendment to the professional services agreement with Ninyo & Moore for additional environmental site assessment services not to exceed a total contract amount of \$31,933;
- Approved the Third Amendment to the Agreement to Provide Services with Southland Transit, Inc. for Dial-A-Ride transportation services, directed staff to return to City Council with a plan on how a Request for Proposals will be structured integrating Dial-A-Ride and on-demand local public transportation for residents by the December 18, 2018 meeting, and on December 18, 2018, directed staff to develop and issue a Request for Proposals for Dial-A-Ride and other transportation programs in January 2019;
- Reviewed and approved the First Amendment to the consultant services agreement with Willdan Engineering to provide housing consultant services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19, which shall not exceed 20 percent of the City's home improvement program's expenditures and shall not exceed \$60,000 and authorized the City Manager to execute the First Amendment;
- Accepted project completion for the Temple City Boulevard Highway Safety Improvement Project (HSIPL-5365(010)), Capital Improvement Project (CIP) No. P 15-06, as performed by All American Asphalt, with a final contract amount of \$1,079,332.34, and authorized the City Manager to file a Notice of Completion with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder and release the retention payment 35 days thereafter;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5331 authorizing the payment of bills;
- Received and filed reimbursement of expenses to City officials for conduct of city business; and
- Received updates from City Attorney and City Manager.
