

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of November 6, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of November 6, 2018, the City Council:

- Recognized Deputy Rick Adams for his 17 years of service to the community;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of October 16, 2018;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of October 31, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meeting on October 10, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting on October 17, 2018;
- Approved relaxing of overnight parking restriction enforcement from 12:00 midnight on Sunday, December 16, 2018 to 11:59 p.m. on Monday, January 7, 2019;
- Authorized staff to submit an application to the Southern California Association of Governments for a 2018 Sustainable Communities Program grant to prepare a Pedestrian Master Plan and Safe Routes to School Plan;
- Affirmed City of Temple City's automatic enrollment in the default rate option of 36% renewable energy program with the Clean Power Alliance;
- Reviewed and approved the final subdivision map for Parcel Map No. 73435 and authorized the City Clerk to certify Parcel Map No. 73435;
- Authorized the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Ring, Inc. for participation in the Ring Subsidy Program and approved a budget amendment in the amount of \$20,000 to subsidize 400 Ring devices;
- Authorized staff to revise various budgeted appropriations for the FY 2017-18 City Budget;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5367 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5361 approving the traffic and pedestrian safety measures recommended by the Transportation and Public Safety Commission and approved a budget amendment in the amount of \$44,000 to implement the approved traffic and pedestrian safety measures;
- Received updates for the City Manager and City Attorney;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular Successor Agency meeting of September 4, 2018; and
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5368-SA authorizing payment of Successor Agency bills.
