

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of March 19, 2019. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of March 19, 2019, the City Council:

- Proclaimed March as Red Cross Month;
- Reorganized and appointed Councilmember Fish as Mayor and Councilmember Chavez as Mayor Pro Tem;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of March 5, 2019;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of March 5, 2019;
- Received and filed the Regular Planning Commission meeting actions of February 28, 2019;
- Received the 2018 General Plan Implementation Report, approved the report, and directed staff to file the report with the Office of Planning and Research and the Department of Housing and Community Development;
- Amended the City's 2018-2023 Capital Improvement Plan to add CIP-42 (Primrose Park and Parking Lot), which funds pre-development and construction activities for a new park and public parking lot on the 5900 block of Primrose Avenue, authorized an allocation of \$43,800 in unspent funds from CIP-12 (Primrose Properties Demolition) to CIP-42 (Primrose Park and Parking Lot) for pre-development activities; and designated \$57, 200 from the General Fund Reserve (undesignated fund balance) to CIP-42 (Primrose Park and Parking Lot), thereby availing a total of \$100,000 for pre-development services, which includes facility design and construction documents.
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5387 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Received an update from the City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
