

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of June 4, 2019. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of June 4, 2019, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Pending Litigation”. There is no reportable action;
- Meet in Closed Session regarding “Anticipated Litigation”. There is no reportable action;
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Labor Negotiator”. There is no reportable action;
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Pending Litigation”. There is no reportable action; and
- Continued the Closed Session regarding “Employee Performance Evaluation” for the City Manager to a future meeting date.

At the regular meeting of June 4, 2019, the City Council:

- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 21, 2019;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 21, 2019;
- Received and filed the actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting of April 23, 2019;
- Received and filed the actions of the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meeting of May 8, 2019;
- Received and filed the actions of the Regular Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting of May 15, 2019;
- Reviewed and approved the Second Amendment to the consultant services agreement with Willdan Engineering to provide housing consultant services for Fiscal Year 2019-20 and increased the total compensation by \$50,000 for a total of \$110,000, and authorized the City Manager to execute the Second Amendment with Willdan for FY 2019-20;
- Accepted the Engineer’s Report for the Temple City Citywide Lighting and Maintenance District and adopted Resolution No. 19-5399;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5400 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Introduced for first reading by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 19-1034, amending Title 9, Chapter 1 of the Temple City Municipal Code pertaining to flag lot subdivisions in the R-1 Zone and scheduled the second reading of Ordinance No. 19-1034 for June 18, 2019;
- Approve a new agreement between the City of Temple City and the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society for animal control, shelter, and licensing services for Fiscal Year 2019-20, and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Introduced Ordinance No. 19-1035 for first reading by title only, amending Titles 4 and 5 of the Temple City Municipal Code relating to Sidewalk and Mobile Food Vending with inclusion of amendment to 4-12-7B to allow City Manager or his designee to issue regulations as needed pertaining to vending in public parks, waived further reading of Ordinance No. 19-1035, and scheduled the second reading of Ordinance No. 19-1035 for June 18, 2019;
- Received updates from the City Manager and City Attorney, and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
