06-10-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred on 6/5 8:02pm, but was reported on 6/10, in the 9600 block of La Rosa Drive. The victim said someone stole a package from his front porch. There was surveillance video of a male wearing black taking the package.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 1:00am – 8:30am in the 6300 block of Hallowell Avenue. The victim said someone stole her personal property from her unlocked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses.

06-13-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 2:24pm in 9400 block of Olema Avenue. The victim said two males (suspects) forcibly shattered the rear sliding glass door of her residence, but fled when the victim shouted at them. Surveillance video showed a female approach the front door, then leave. A short time later, a silver vehicle (suspect vehicle) pulled into the driveway and two male suspects (wearing hoodies) entered the backyard of the location.

06-15-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between at 4:30pm in the 5000 block of Kauffman Avenue. The victim said two males (suspects) entered his residence through an unlocked window, but nothing appeared to be missing at the time. The victim was asleep, when he was awakened and saw two suspects (wearing hoodies) inside of his residence. The suspects immediately fled from the location and entered a newer model white sedan (possible infinity) driven by a third suspect.
