- Approved the renewal of the Municipal Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the County of Los Angeles and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5405 adopting the Statement of Investment Policy for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Received and filed the Legislative Update;
- Received and filed the Petty Cash and Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5406 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5402, ordering the levy and collection of assessments for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5401 adopting the Annual Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2019-20;

- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5403 approving the Master Fee and Fine Schedule for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5404 adopting the budget and approving appropriations for the City of Temple City for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020;
- Received updates from the City Manager and City Attorney, and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
