07-22-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 7:30pm in the 4900 block of Sereno Drive. The victim said someone stole her personal property from her back yard. There was video depicting a female Hispanic (suspect).

07-23-19

- An **Armed Robbery & Home Invasion** occurred at 4:00pm in the 5900 block of Hart Avenue. A male Black (suspect) knocked at the victim's front door. When the victim answered, the suspect pointed a gun at her and forced her inside. The victim was tied-up, as the suspect rummaged through the house. The victim suffered minor injuries. This is an ongoing investigation.

07-24-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 11:30am in the 6300 block of Golden West Avenue. Two male Blacks (suspects) knocked at the front door, but the victim didn't answer. The suspects forcibly entered the location through a rear window and stole the victim's personal property. The suspects fled when they discovered the victim was home and left in a red sedan, which was parked in the victim's driveway. This is an ongoing investigation.

07-25-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred between 7/24 9:00pm – 7/25 7:50am in the 4500 block of Ellis Lane. The victim said someone stole the rear license plate from his vehicle. There were no reported witnesses.

07-26-19

- Deputies arrested a FH/40 & MH/32 for **Possession of a Controlled Substance & Possession of Drug Paraphernalia** in the 10800 block of Grand Avenue. Deputies responded to a call of a person screaming at the location. The male suspect possessed suspected narcotics (was on probation for narcotics) and the female suspect possessed suspected narcotics paraphernalia. The suspects were residents of Baldwin Park & Long Beach.
- Deputies arrested a MW/32 at 7:30pm for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Suspected Narcotics & Narcotics Paraphernalia** in the 5400 block of Cloverly Avenue. Deputies contacted the suspect for possible trespassing, and saw the suspect displayed the sign/symptom of being under the influence of narcotics & possessed suspected narcotics & narcotics paraphernalia. The suspect is a resident of El Monte.
