

Loan

Funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the City's rehabilitation loans are available to low-income property owners having a single-family residence. The zero-interest loan, with a maximum of \$35,000, can be used to pay for various home repairs. No monthly payments are required, and the loan does not need to be paid back until the property is sold, refinanced, transferred, or changes from owner-occupied to a rental unit.

Grant

The City also offers a handyworker grant, which allows up to \$10,000 worth of eligible home repairs.

Lead/Asbestos

Participants will receive free lead/asbestos testing. If the home contains lead/asbestos, free containment or abatement work will be provided.

- Kitchen remodel
- Bathroom remodel
- Sewer replacement
- Water main replacement
- Electrical meter replacement
- Roof repair and/or replacement
- Exterior stucco/painting
- Air conditioning/heating repair/replacement
- Windows/Doors replacement
- Major drywall/ceiling repairs
- Interior painting
- Plumbing fixture replacement
- Electrical fixture replacement
- Attic/wall insulation
- Flooring replacement
- Water Heater replacement

How To Qualify?

In order to qualify for the loan or grant program, the property owners must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Own a property that is single-family residential
- 2) Property is located within the city limits
- 3) Property is owner-occupied
- 4) Property has no more than 2 liens and the total indebtedness cannot exceed 75% after the improvements (loan program only)
- 5) Total household income is below the annual income limits listed below.
