



# CRIME BLOTTER: 09/15/19 – 09/21/19

## 09-15-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 2:43pm, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The informant said two female Blacks (suspects) entered the location and took a number of items, then exited without paying. There was a reported witness and surveillance video.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 7:51pm, in the 5900 block of Temple City Boulevard. The victim said a male White (suspect) stole her personal property from the rear yard of the location. The victim saw the suspect cut the cable securing the stolen property. There was surveillance video of the suspect loading the property onto a wagon and pushing it away.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred at 4:13pm, in the 9600 block of Las Tunas Drive. The informant allowed a male Hispanic (suspect) to test an item prior to purchasing, when the suspect left the location and failed to return with the property. There was surveillance video and other evidence left at the location.

## 09-16-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 11:30am, in the 9800 block of Daines Drive. The victim said two suspects (wearing masks) forcibly shattered the rear glass door of the location, and stole her personal property. There was surveillance video of the incident.

## 09-19-19

- An **Armed Robbery** occurred at 12:15am, in the 9900 block of Broadway. The victims were approached by two male Blacks (suspects) who pointed a gun at them and demanded their money. The suspects took the money and ran to a nearby waiting vehicle (light colored vehicle). This is an ongoing investigation.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred between 4:00pm - 4:30pm, at Oak Avenue/Longden Avenue. The victim said someone (suspect) stole his personal property from his unlocked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses.
