10-27-19

- Deputies arrested a FB/33 at 4:20pm for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance**, in the 6200 block of Muscatel Avenue. Deputies responded to a disturbance call and contacted the suspect who displayed the signs/symptom of being under the influence of a controlled substance. The suspect is a resident of Temple City.

10-28-19

- A **Garage Burglary** occurred between 10/25 7:00pm – 10/26 8:00am, but was reported on 10/28, in the 5500 block of Temple City Boulevard. The victim said someone entered his unlocked garage and stole his personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
