



CRIME BLOTTER: 11/10/19 – 11/16/19

11-10-19

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 11/9 9:30pm – 11/10 4:30am in the 5100 block of Doreen Avenue. The victim said someone entered his locked and secured vehicle. There was no sign of forced entry and no reported witnesses.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred between 11/7/19 6:00pm – 11/10 2:00pm, in the 5900 block of Temple City Boulevard. The informant said someone forcibly entered the location by shattering the front glass door window, then unlocking the door. The informant was unsure if anything was missing at the time. There were no reported witnesses.

11-11-19

- A **Theft by Access Card & Petty Theft** occurred between 10:25am – 11:00am, at Callita Street/Rosemead Boulevard. The victim said someone stole her wallet containing her credit card, when she briefly left it unattended. She discovered someone used her credit card a short time later to make a purchase. This is an ongoing investigation.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred between 2:00am – 3:00am, in the 9200 block of Las Tunas Drive. The informant said someone forcibly shattered the front glass door of the business and stole merchandise from the location. There was surveillance video of the incident.

11-13-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred between 11/12 9:30pm – 11/13 7:15am, in the 4800 block of Agnes Avenue. The victim said someone entered her unlocked Vehicle and stole her personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred at 11:40am, in the 5300 block of Persimmon Avenue. The victim said someone stole his property from the front yard of the location, when he briefly left it unattended. A witness saw a male and female Hispanic (suspects) take the property, then enter a white pick-up truck (possible Ford).

11-14-19

- Deputies arrested a MW/32 at 7:49am for **Vandalism, Violation of a Court Order, & Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia**, in the 9500 block of Garibaldi Avenue. Deputies responded to a restraining order violation and contacted the suspect, who knowingly violated the restraining order, possessed narcotics paraphernalia and damaged county property. The suspect is a resident of El Monte.

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 6:30am – 1:00pm, in the 5300 block of Temple City Boulevard. The victim said someone forcibly shattered his front window and stole his personal property. There was a witness who saw three male Blacks (suspects) walking towards the front of the location and out of view, then running from the location carrying a white pillow case. The suspects entered a gray vehicle (possible BMW).
- Deputies arrested a FH/40 & FH/51 at 7:00pm for **Possession of a Controlled Substance**, in the 9700 block of Las Tunas Drive. The suspects were contacted, during an illegal parking investigation and possessed suspected narcotics. The suspects are residents of Temple City & Pasadena.

11-15-19

- A **Robbery Strong Arm** occurred at 8:45am, at Las Tunas Drive/Oak Street. The victim said she was walking, when a black vehicle stopped parallel to her. The female Hispanic (suspect) passenger exited the passenger side of the vehicle and grabbed her purse. The male Hispanic driver (suspect) also exited the vehicle and assisted with taking the victim's purse. The suspects overpowered the victim and took her purse, then reentered the vehicle.

11-16-19

- Deputies arrested a FH/42 at 12:26pm for **Petty Theft**, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The informant saw the suspect take items from the location, then exit without paying. The suspect was detained by store security and placed under private persons arrests. There was surveillance of the incident. The suspect is a resident of San Gabriel.
