

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of January 7, 2020. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of January 7, 2020, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Labor Negotiator”. There is no reportable action.

At the regular meeting of January 7, 2020, the City Council:

- Received a presentation introducing Pet of the Month. Those interested in adopting a pet can call the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society at (626) 286-1159;
- Recognized winners of the City’s 2019 Holiday Decorating Contest;
- Recognized Mr. Timothy Ting for 32 years of service with the United States Postal Service in the City of Temple City;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of December 17, 2019;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of December 17, 2019;
- Received and filed the actions of the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meeting Actions of December 11, 2019;
- Authorized use of City owned facilities including Live Oak Park Community Center, Temple City Park, and the Community Room as identified in the attached letter from the Camellia Festival to the City Manager, authorized use of streets and parking areas including temporary parking bans and street closures for the festival and parade as identified in the attached letter from the Camellia Festival to the City Manager, approved the permit for use of the Los Angeles County (County) Library parking lot for the 2020 Camellia Festival (if available prior to the library construction project) and authorize staff to execute, approved consumption of alcohol in Temple City Park, pursuant to Section 4-4-0 of the Temple City Municipal Code (TCMC), authorized Bingo in Temple City Park, pursuant to Section 4-1F of the TCMC and waiver of the \$50 license fee, authorized sponsor banners in Temple City Park and Live Oak Park, pursuant to Section 3-5D-10 of the TCMC, authorized placement of banners in City parks and the median located on Broadway at Encinita, pursuant to Section 9-1L-3C of the TCMC, and authorized certain local community organizations to sell food, patches, etc. along the parade route;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5444 approving the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Temple City and the Temple City Employees Association and appropriated \$55,100 from the General Fund Reserves and \$3,050 from the Lighting and Landscape District Fund Reserves to implement the provisions of the MOU;
- Received and filed the Petty Cash Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5443 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Introduced, read by title, waived further reading, and adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 20-1038U to

temporarily prohibit within the MU-C zone public market uses and the subdivision of parcel and tenant spaces;

- Received updates from the City Manager and City Attorney, and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
