03-22-21

- Deputies on routine patrol conducted a felony traffic stop of a **Stolen Vehicle**, that was reported by Costa Mesa Police Department on 02/04, at 7:00pm in the 5300 block of Temple City Blvd. as it was traveling northbound. A suspect was arrested, and is a resident of Tustin.

03-23-21

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 9:00am and 2:30pm in the 6200 block of Kauffman Ave. Unknown suspect(s) entered the residence by sliding open an unsecured kitchen window, ransacked the victim's son's bedroom, and stole a set of keys. No other room at the residence was disturbed. There were no audible alarm, surveillance, or witnesses to the incident.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 4:45pm in the 5500 block of Rosemead Blvd. Deputies on routine patrol of a vacant property observed a suspect exiting a window to the boarded property while carrying a bag. Deputies detained the suspect, who was later arrested for commercial burglary because the bag contained miscellaneous copper metals. He is a resident of El Monte.

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred in the 5000 block of Camellia Ave. Suspect(s) entered the victim's unlocked vehicle and stole miscellaneous documents. There were no witnesses or surveillance of the incident.
