

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of December 7, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

The Special meeting of December 7, 2021, was cancelled.

At the Regular meeting of December 7, 2021, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of November 16, 2021;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of November 9, 2021;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5570 approving and authorizing execution of Master Agreement Administering Agency-State Agreement for State Funded Projects No. 07-5365S21 and Program Supplement No. W48 between Caltrans and the City of Temple City for the Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP);
- Authorized use of City owned facilities, as identified in the attached letter from the Camellia Festival to the City Manager (Attachment "A"); authorized use of streets and parking areas including temporary parking bans and street closures for the festival and parade as identified in the attached letter from the Camellia Festival to the City Manager; approved the permit for use of the Los Angeles County (County) Library parking lot for the 2022 Camellia Festival and authorize staff to execute (if available prior to the library construction project); authorized Bingo in Temple City Park, pursuant to Section 4-1F of the TCMC and waiver of the \$50 license fee; authorized sponsor banners in Temple City Park and Live Oak Park, pursuant to Section 3-5D-10 of the TCMC; authorized use of City's Social Media accounts to advertise Camellia Festival activities; and authorized Camellia Festival banners and flags in Temple City Park, pursuant to Section 3-5D-10 of the TCMC;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5571 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Opened public hearing to receive public comments for the introduction of adoption of Urgency Ordinance No. 21-1058 U (Attachment "B") and introduction of Ordinance No. 21-1059 amending Title 3, Chapter 3, and Title 9, Chapters 1 and 2, of the Municipal Code (Attachment "C"); and continued the public hearing to the next City Council meeting on December 21, 2021;
- Continued the item relating to the adoption of Resolution No. 21-5572 to allow City Council to continue the use of teleconferencing or videoconferencing for Brown Act-covered public meetings of the City Council and City commissions for another 30 days;
- Continued the item relating to the naming of park on Primrose Avenue;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
