City to Present Strategies in Growing its Redevelopment Program *Community workshop to receive public input set for January 27*

The Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency and Temple City Chamber of Commerce will host a community workshop on January 27 to discuss options and solicit input on how the city should grow its redevelopment program.

The workshop begins at 7:30 p.m. in the community meeting room at Westminster Presbyterian Church, 9642 Live Oak Ave., Temple City.

Among the topics for discussion:

- Necessary amendments to the city's redevelopment plan that furthers the ability to complete and fund future projects in the Rosemead Blvd. Redevelopment Project Area.
- Proposed expansion of the redevelopment project area to possibly include the Las Tunas Dr. corridor, the industrial segment along Lower Azusa Rd., and areas adjacent to Rosemead Blvd. south of Broadway to city limits.
- The importance of Temple City Plaza (formerly the Piazza project) and other future developments in providing new retail opportunities, and additional revenues for city services and continued redevelopment activities.

"This workshop will educate on the tools necessary to create a healthy and vibrant Temple City," said Mayor Fernando Vizcarra. "As always, we'll be looking to the community to help us create a redevelopment program."

This meeting culminates a recent series of community workshops to discuss challenges and opportunities to revitalize the city's commercial and industrial corridors. The effort will result in a redevelopment strategy to guide city investment for the next 15 years.
