Rosemead Blvd. Environmental Document Available for Public Review

An environmental document for the proposed Rosemead Blvd. Enhancement Project is now available for public review.

Technically known as a negative declaration, the draft document finds no significant environmental impacts associated with the City's plans to transform its two-mile segment of Rosemead Blvd. into an accessible, pedestrian-friendly corridor.

Planned improvements call for new sidewalks, street amenities, landscaped medians, public art displays, protected bike lanes, traffic calming measures, and critical road and drainage enhancements.

The draft document can be downloaded from the City's website at www.templecity.us. It can also be viewed at City Hall, 9701 Las Tunas Dr. and Temple City Library, 5939 Golden West Ave.

The public may provide written comments on the document's findings until February 29. The City will also hold public hearings to solicit verbal and written statements on February 28 and March 6, 7:30 p.m., in the Temple City Council Chambers, 5938 Kauffman Ave.

If approved by the City Council on March 6, the document will allow the \$17 million project to break ground this summer.
