Temple Citians wanting to get more involved in their community can start by volunteering on a city commission. The deadline for applications is May 31, 6 p.m.

Three seats are open on the Planning Commission, which has decision-making authority on a variety of development proposals. Commissioners advise on programs, policies and issues relating to planning, development and land use regulation. The commission meets the second and fourth Tuesday of the month at 7:30 p.m.

Three seats are also open on the Parks and Recreation Commission, which makes recommendations on the development and oversight of the City's parks facilities and recreational programming. That commission meets the third Wednesday of the month at 7:30 p.m.

Both commissions act in an advisory capacity to the City Council by studying, discussing and recommending solutions on issues of importance to the Temple City community.

Applications to fill the vacancies can be downloaded from the City's website (www.templecity.us) and obtained during normal business hours from City Hall, 9701 Las Tunas Dr. Applicants must be a registered voter and resident of Temple City.

Those selected serve without compensation for two-year terms. The City does cover commissioner costs for training and conferences as resources allow.

The City Council will select commissioners through an interview process. Those appointed to the positions will begin their terms July 1.
