Widely known as the "Home of the Camellias," Temple City is a young city interested in youth activities. From the annual Camellia Festival, held since 1945 on the last Saturday in February, to the year round parks and recreation program. Temple City encourages youngsters to participate in the affairs of the community.

**LOCATION:** Western San Gabriel Valley, 15 miles northeast of the Los Angeles Civic Center. The Major thoroughfares of Rosemead Boulevard, Las Tunas Drive and Baldwin Avenue intersect the city.

**POPULATION:** Approximately 34,000 - Average family size is 2.77 persons.

**AREA:** Approximately 3.85 square miles. The elevation is 403 feet and the average temperature is 76.1 annually.

**GOVERNMENT:** Council-Manager form a government, operating under the Contract Cities plan to provide excellent and economic major municipal services through contracts with the county and private sources.

**TAX RATE:** No real or personal property tax levied by the city. No bonded indebtedness.

**SCHOOLS:** Excellent educational opportunities are provided by both public and private schools from kindergarten through 12th grade. Two Community Colleges and a California State University provide higher education only a few miles from the community.
