TENNIS COURT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. City conducted programs have priority over all other use.
2. Courts will be open between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. daily except for holidays when hours may vary. Courts will be closed on Thanksgiving and Christmas.
3. All persons using the courts shall wear rubber soled athletic shoes.
4. No food or liquids, except water, are to be brought on the courts (exception is made for medical emergencies).
5. No private tennis lessons for profit are allowed on tennis courts except for those taught by an instructor who has obtained a permit from the City of Temple City, pays a fee of \$5 per hour, and provides the City with an insurance endorsement naming the City as an additional insured.
6. The courts are provided for tennis playing only; No other activities are allowed except as provided in rule #1.
7. The official U.S. Lawn Tennis Association rules of tennis shall prevail.
8. Use of courts is on a first come, first served basis. When others are waiting and no courts is available:
 - a. warming up before matches or rallying must not exceed 5 minutes;
 - b. only one set of singles or one set of doubles may be played;
 - c. sets resulting in six-all shall be determined by one additional game;
 - d. waiting players must remain in person at courts desired and shall be physically present to take possession of the court when relinquished;
 - e. players not wishing to play a set may instead rally for 60 minutes after which the court must be relinquished;
 - f. the substitution of players is not permitted.
9. A maximum of four (4) courts may be reserved for tournaments or club play for non-profit organizations who secure permission in writing from the City and pay a fee of \$3 per hour. An insurance endorsement, naming the City of Temple City as an additional insured is required.

Note: Lights are on a time clock and automatically turn off shortly before 10 p.m.
