



# CRIME BLOTTER: 01/24/20 – 01/30/21

## 01-24-21

- Deputies arrested a MH/42 for **Possession of a Controlled Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia** at 12:08pm, in the 4500 block of Temple City Boulevard. A Deputy was conducting a patrol check of a business and saw a person sitting on a bench near the business. A no trespassing sign was clearly posted on the business. The Deputy contacted the person regarding the trespassing investigation. The suspect was in possession a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested. The suspect is a resident of Rosemead.

## 01-25-21

- A **Burglary (Commercial)** occurred between 01/22 at 6:30pm and 01/25 at 6:00am, in the 9800 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) forced entry into her locked business and stole miscellaneous office equipment from inside. There was no video surveillance of the incident.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 01/24 at 5:30pm and 01/25 at 8:00am, in the 5600 block of Santa Anita Avenue. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) entered her locked vehicle and stole personal property. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.

- A **Petty Theft (Shoplifting)** occurred at 8:15am in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) entered the business carrying a bag. The suspect walked around putting merchandise inside the bag. The suspect left the store without paying for the merchandise. There was no video surveillance of the incident.

- Deputies arrested a MH/31 for **Assault on a Peace Officer and Public Intoxication** at 12:14pm, in the 9500 block of Lower Azusa Road. Deputies responded to a business disturbance call, where the suspect was refusing to leave a location. The suspect was sitting on a stool with his head down on a table. The suspect was unresponsive to verbal commands and the Deputy nudging his shoulder. The suspect's arm was lifted by the Deputy to check if medical attention was needed. The suspect began swinging his arms and hitting the Deputy. The suspect was eventually controlled and handcuffed. It was also determined the suspect was under the influence of alcohol. The suspect is a transient.

- Deputies arrested a MH/28, MH/33 and a FH/29 for **Burglary, Conspiracy to Commit a Crime, Possession of a Controlled Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia** at 4:30pm in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Deputies were driving on Rosemead Boulevard and saw a suspect standing next to a wall. The suspect appeared to be throwing copper wire to the other side of the wall. Deputies drove into the parking lot and saw a parked vehicle with two other suspects standing near it. On the floor next to the parked vehicle was more copper wire. It was determined the suspects driving the vehicle met with the initial suspect to load the copper wire that was stolen. Deputies recovered a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. The suspects are residents of Pomona, Temple City and El Monte.
- Deputies arrested a MB/30 for **Possession of a Controlled Substance** at 7:25pm, in the intersection of Temple City Boulevard and Live Oak Avenue. Deputies conducted a traffic stop for traffic violations. During the traffic stop, Deputies discovered the suspect had outstanding warrants. The suspect was also in possession of a controlled substance. The suspect was arrested. The suspect is a resident of Los Angeles.
- A **Stolen Vehicle** occurred at 7:30pm in the 9600 block of Olive Street. The victim said unknown suspect(s) stole his locked vehicle, which was parked on the street in front of his residence. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.
