

# CRIME BLOTTER: 02/14/21 - 02/20/21

## 02-14-21

- A Commercial Burglary occurred between 8:30pm and 8:45pm, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The Informant stated unknown suspect(s) entered the business through the rear door on the back of the building. While inside the business the suspect stole several items. There was video surveillance of the incident.
