



# CRIME BLOTTER: 04/04/21 – 04/10/21

## 04-05-21

- Deputies arrested two suspects, MB/27 and MB/22, for **Shoplifting** at 7:49am, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The two suspects entered the business and placed several items inside bags they were carrying. The suspects exited the store without paying for the items. Responding Deputies detained the suspects several blocks away from the business. The suspects were identified and arrested. Both are residents of Los Angeles.

## 04-06-21

- A **Petty Theft** occurred on 03-31-21 at 12:01pm in the 9100 block of Hermosa Drive, but was reported today. Unknown suspect(s) stole the victim's package from the front porch. There was no video surveillance of the incident.

## 04-07-21

- A **Robbery (Estes)** occurred at 12:04am in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim stated while one of the suspects was at the register trying to pay for an item, a second suspect pushing a shopping cart full of merchandise walked past the registers towards the exit. An employee got in front of the shopping cart to stop the suspect from walking out with the unpaid merchandise. The initial suspect, who was paying for an item, approached the employee and began yelling at him. The suspect then shoved the employee out of the way, then both suspects exited the store and entered a vehicle that was waiting in front of the store for them. They drove off out of view as another employee wrote down their license plate.

## 04-09-21

- A **Grand Theft (Catalytic Converter)** occurred between 04-08 at 8:00pm and 04-09 at 1:00pm in the 10000 block of Live Oak Avenue. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from her vehicle. There was no video surveillance of the incident.
- A **Grand Theft (Catalytic Converter)** occurred at 1:00am in the 5500 block of Ryland Avenue. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from her vehicle. There was no video surveillance of the incident.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred on 04-06 at 5:12pm in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard, but was reported today. Unknown suspect(s) carrying reusable bags entered the business. The suspect(s) walked around the store and selected several items from clothing racks and shoe shelves. The suspect(s) then walked to a section in the store and concealed all the merchandise in the reusable bags, and exited the store without paying for any of the items. There was video surveillance of the incident.
