04-11-21

- Deputies arrested a FH for **Battery and Hate Crime** at 10:35am, in the 5900 block of Agnes Avenue. The suspect instigated a verbal argument with the victim using racial slur. When the victim told the suspect to leave her property, the suspect physically assaulted the victim by pushing her out of the way. Responding Deputies detained the suspect several blocks away from the location pending further investigation. The suspect was arrested after being identified. She is a resident of Los Angeles.

04-12-21

- Deputies arrested a MH for **Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine)** on at 2:58am, in the 4900 block of Persimmon Avenue. Deputies responding to the location regarding a family disturbance and vandalism call made contact with the suspect, and detained him pending an investigation. During the investigation, the suspect was arrested on the above charge after admitting to possession of a controlled substance. He is a resident of Santa Ana.

04-13-21

- Deputies arrested a MH and a FH for **Trespassing** at 10:00am, in the intersection of the rail road track and Temple City Blvd. Deputies patrolled the area for transient encampment and detained the two suspects, who were building a small encampment. Deputies later arrested the two suspects for the above charge. They are both residents of El Monte.

04-14-21

- A **Residence Burglary** occurred between 04-12 11:00pm and 04-13 3:00pm, in the 9500 block of Woodruff Avenue, but was reported today. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) entered the vacant house through the rear window of the location. There was no video surveillance of the incident.

- A **Residence Burglary** occurred between 04-14 6:00pm and 04-15 7:00am, in the 5300 block of Santa Anita Avenue, but was reported today. The victim stated unknown suspect(s) entered the house through the garage entrance and stole miscellaneous personal items. The victim also stated the suspect(s) used the garage door opener, which was inside her unlocked vehicle that was parked in the driveway, and opened the garage door. There was no video surveillance of the incident.
